SALE OF PETROL AND AUTOMOTIVE DIESEL IS SUBJECT TO [LEVEL] RESTRICTIONS

The Governor-General has declared a period of national liquid fuel emergency. Restrictions have been applied to the purchase of [fuel type] as indicated below.

What can I purchase at service stations?

A maximum purchase limit of [X] dollars of fuel per vehicle per day applies

You will not be able to fill a storage container with fuel. However, if you are stranded because your vehicle has run out of fuel, you may purchase up to 5 litres of fuel in a suitable container.

Where they exist, card operated facilities on bowsers will be allowed up to the maximum sales limit and at the discretion of the retail site operator.

What are essential services?

The following are essential service vehicles, where the supply of fuel is essential to the provision of the service:

- Police services;
- Corrective services:

- Ambulance services:
- State Emergency Services or their equivalent;
- Defence vehicles
- Public transport services; and
- Taxi services.

Alternative travel arrangements

If you cannot access enough fuel for your usual requirements you should consider alternative travel arrangement, particularly for journeys you make regularly. You should note in this context that public transport and taxis are exempt from restrictions.

The decision to restrict the sale of these fuels has not been taken lightly and is intended to ensure these fuels are available for essential community services.
